Spinal Fellowship

St Vincent's Hospital (Melbourne) offers a 12 months spinal fellowship to commence in February 2019. This is a Post-Fellowship Education Training (PFET) accredited position through the Neurosurgical Society of Australasia and the department welcomes applications for this position.

The Neurosurgery Department of St Vincent's Hospital (Melbourne) is a busy tertiary hospital treating over 2500 patients annually across the public and private campuses. There are 9 neurosurgeons and there is a strong interest in spinal conditions and spine surgery. The breadth of spinal experience will include complex spinal reconstructive surgery with exposure to both open and minimally invasive techniques as well as standard spinal decompressive surgery.

Successful applicants will be expected to gain experience in both the public and private hospitals and will be responsible for running independent complex spinal clinics and spinal multi-disciplinary meetings. On-call responsibilities will be approximately one in five. Established research projects are currently running in the department and the spine fellow will be expected to participate strongly in these activities.
